Zero-tolerance policy against damage

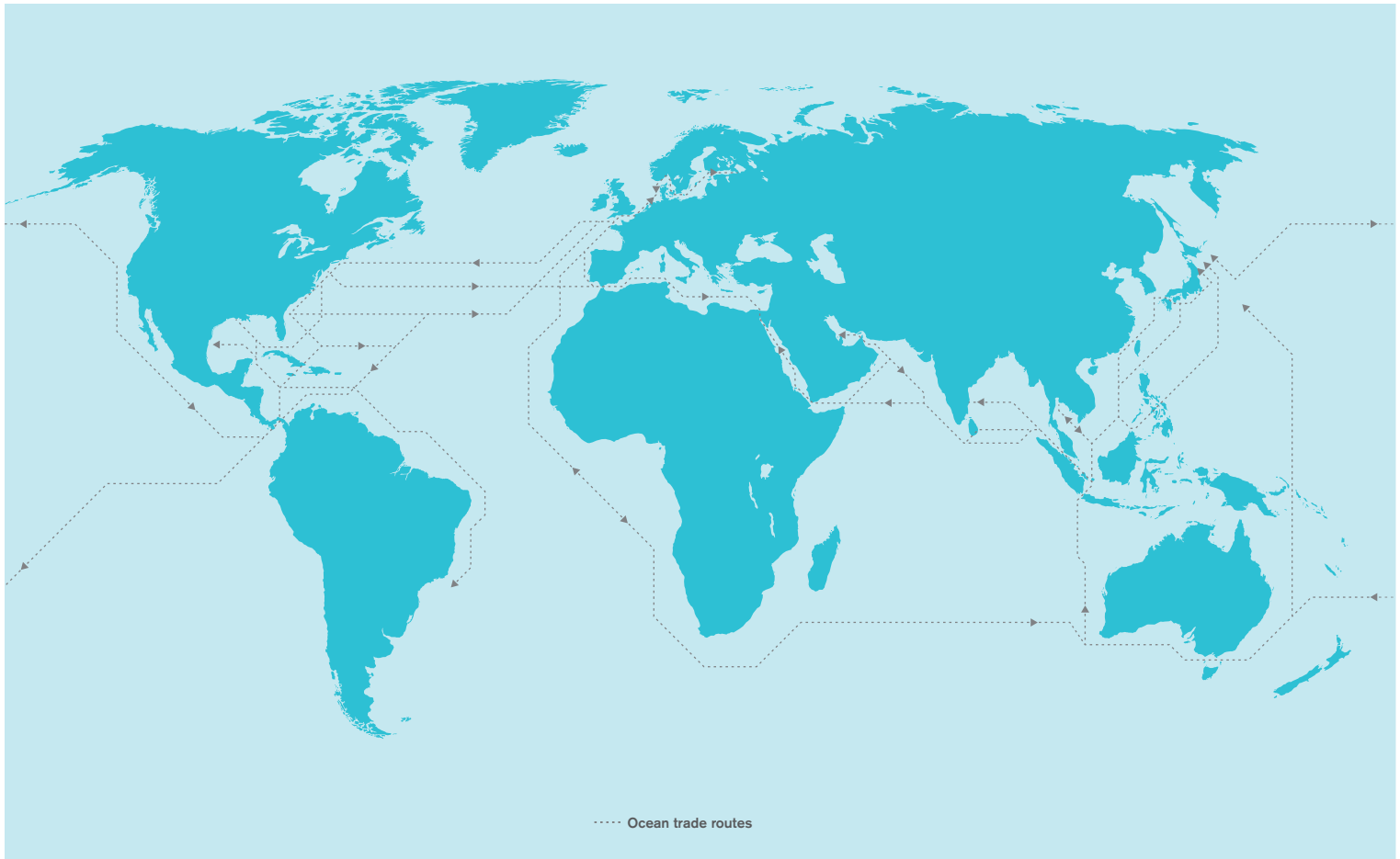
